

TIME WARP SOCKS

This isn't so much a pattern as a chart for embellishing all kinds of socks with a witty reference to your favorite movie – the **ROCKY HORROR PICTURE SHOW**. So... come up to the lab and see what's on the slab! I see you shiver with antici.....pation!



MATERIALS:

- 100g of your favorite, preferably solid or semi-solid colored fingering sock yarn – I used Lana Grossa Meilenweit in some nondescript grey
- leftovers of a fingering yarn in a contrast color – red is a RHPS color for me, so I searched my stash for a bit of that, but any color will do.

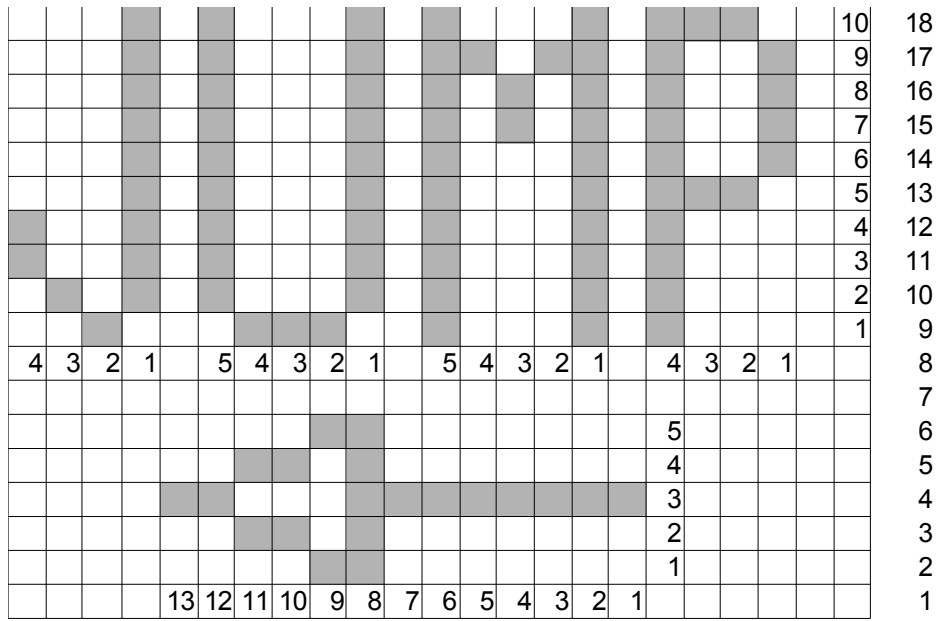
INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Throw open the switches on the sonic oscillator... and step up the reactor!
2. Make a pair of plain, basic socks. I won't go into detail here, there are tons of free or not free sock patterns around, like [this one](#). It doesn't matter if you do it toe-up, cuff-down, decide on a short-row or a flap heel, or work 10 or 20 rounds of ribbing. Just do whatever you feel most comfortable with.

However, there is one requirement, if you want to place the Time Warp instructions where I did: you'll need at least 20 rows of stockinette stitch between ribbing and heel, since the letters plus arrow are 18 rows high, and I found it wise to leave at least 2 rows between ribbing and any kind of duplicate stitch.

3. Thread a darning needle with a length of the cc yarn, get out the charts, and [duplicate stitch](#) away. The space between the second and third letters is the center stitch, so make sure that is in the vicinity of the beginning of the round.
4. Weave in all ends, slip on... and do the Time Warp again!
